

## The C1 Form

It is the law that companies who want to dispose of or move hazardous waste within the 26 counties must complete a C.1 Form.

The completed C.1. Form must then be given to the company collecting the waste e.g. Rilta Environmental Ltd. Failure to complete the C1 form will lead to severe penalties under the Waste Management Act.

## How to get a supply of C.1. Forms?

1. Contact your Local Authority and order a stock of C.1. Forms.
2. There may be a charge made by the Local Authority for the C.1. Form.

There are **five** carbon copies of the C.1. Form.

What happens then after the company disposing of the waste has completed the C.1. Form?

- **White Copy:** Retained by the consignee or the driver
- **Green Copy:** Sent to the Local Authority in the jurisdiction where the waste originates
- **Blue Copy:** Forwarded to South Dublin County Council – as the Hazardous Waste is being taken into their jurisdiction.
- **Yellow Copy:** Retained by Rilta Environmental Ltd.
- **Pink Copy:** Retained by the company disposing of the waste for their records
